Dear Parents:

Registration for the PTA's Winter After School Enrichment Program (ASEP) begins on Friday, December 11th at 6pm and continues through Friday, December 18th at noon. Go to www.keyschooldc.org for ASEP registration starting Dec. 11 at 6:00 pm.

Please note the following:

1. Classes are \$75.00 each + materials fee (if applicable). Since there are fewer Friday classes, these are \$65.00 + materials fee (if applicable).
2. KEHP Discount: If your child is enrolled in KEHP (Key Extended Hours Program - After Care) and an ASEP class on the same day, tuition for the ASEP class will be \$35.00 for each class where this situation occurs. Friday classes are \$30.00.
3. Classes that are under-enrolled are subject to cancellation. We will notify parents as soon as possible if a cancellation occurs as we understand the complicated nature of family schedules.
4. Classes that are over-subscribed will use a lottery to determine participation with parents being notified as soon as humanly possible.

Registration is online again this year starting Friday, December 11th, at 6pm at www.keyschooldc.org. **You will need to register each child separately.** Payment is due by check made payable to Key PTA. Please write your child(ren)'s name in the "memo" field on your check and drop it off in the main office ASEP box by the end of the day on Friday, December 18th. **Payment must be received to secure a spot in the class.**
